We are delighted that Stephen Hammond, MP for Wimbledon, made two nominations for the Trust, including the Lifetime Achievement Award for Dr Lynne Drummond, who retires this year after devoting more than 40 years of service to the NHS. During her time at the Trust, Dr Drummond has consistently championed those living with Obsessive-compulsive disorder and Body dysmorphic disorder, and has contributed to several TV documentaries and radio broadcasts.
