

## About the centre

Jubilee Health Centre is a busy, modern health facility designed around the needs of local people.

The Centre provides patients with access to a wide range of health services offered by local NHS providers.

- Sutton and Merton Community Services
- Community Special Dental Services
- Sutton and Merton IAPT
- South West London and St George's Mental Health NHS Trust

There are also two GP practices located in the building.

- Shotfield Medical Practice
- Wallington Family Practice

### Opening times

Jubilee Health Centre West is open Monday to Saturday. Jubilee Health Centre East is open Monday to Friday. Clinics operate at different times, please check your appointment letter or contact your healthcare provider for information about your appointment.

### Healthcare services

Services are available on different days and at different times. Some services are offered on a 'walk in' basis (eg blood tests) but the majority will require an appointment.

You may have received a letter with information about your appointment but you may have been given an appointment over the phone. If you are unsure about your appointment time, or have any other questions, please contact your healthcare provider.

The Wallington Family Practice and Shotfield Medical Practice are located on the ground and first floors of Jubilee West.

Other healthcare services (including hospital outpatient clinics, X-ray, ultrasound, blood tests (phlebotomy), special dental services, physiotherapy and child health services) are located on ground, first and second floors of Jubilee West. Mental health services are located in Jubilee East. CAMHS is on the ground floor, IAPT is on the first floor and adult mental health services are on the second floor.

All floors are accessible by lift and stairs.

## Your information



## When you arrive

The Jubilee Health Centre comprises two buildings – Jubilee East and Jubilee West.

The main reception area for Jubilee health Centre West is on the ground floor. You will see an Information Desk and two GP Reception Desks. There is a large waiting area and self-service 'check-in' screens (for GP appointments only). There are other reception desks and waiting areas on the first and second floors of the building. In Jubilee Health Centre East, the reception desk for CAMHS is on the Ground Floor, IAPT reception is on the first floor and adult mental health services is on the second floor.

### Finding your way around

If you are not sure where to go for your appointment, please ask for help from the staff at the Information Desk on the ground floor or the reception staff at the other reception desks in the building.

## Facilities

### Information desk

Staff on the information desk will be able to help you if you need assistance.

### Refreshments

Water fountains are available in the Centre. There are several cafés in the local area. The closest café to the Centre is in Wallington Library.

### Hearing loop

The centre has a hearing loop.


### Pushchair park

## How to get here

### By bus

Jubilee Health Centre is easily accessible by bus from Sutton, St Helier Hospital, Morden, Tooting, Mitcham, Crystal Palace, Coulsdon, Croydon and Purley. The 151 and 410 buses stop right outside the entrance to the Health Centre. The 127, 154, 157, 455, 463 and S4 buses stop at Stanley Park Road or Woodcote Road. Please see the map for more details.

### By train

Wallington rail station is approximately 500 metres from the Centre. There are frequent train services to and from London (Victoria and, at peak times only, London Bridge), Clapham Junction, Sutton and West Croydon. ### By car

There are disabled parking spaces and a patient drop-off point outside the Shotfield entrance. This is controlled by a barrier. There is no other parking at the Centre. Pay and display car parks are located nearby on Shotfield, by Wallington Library and behind Wallington Hall on Woodcote Road.

### By bicycle

Secure bicycle and motorcycle parking is located to the left of the entrance on Shotfield.

### Travel information
