



## **Systemic Family Psychotherapy Training Intermediate Level : Contextualising Change**

If you have completed Year One of a Systemic Family Psychotherapy Course and would like to continue your training at the Prudence Skynner Family and Couple Therapy Clinic, applications are now being accepted for the Intermediate Level Course (Year Two).

This course is described as an “excellent training programme” by the Association for Family Therapy. It enables professionals from a variety of statutory and voluntary organisations to further develop therapeutic skills with families, couples and individuals.

We focus on systemic approaches across the life span, with a broad range of client groups, alongside deepening theoretical knowledge. The trainers are all UKCP registered Family Therapists and use a variety of didactic and experiential methods.

The course continues to invite course participants to consider their identities and beliefs, such as gender, ethnicity, spiritual beliefs and the positive connections these bring to their work.

### **Start Date**

The course will begin in Autumn 2017 and is spread over ten and a half days – 63 hours. It is taught on a Wednesday.

### **Applications**

Places are limited and will be offered after successful interview and two references. The closing date for applications is 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017.
